POLICY AND REGULATIONS 2018



All players of the West Adelaide Soccer Club including U/5's - U/17's must adhere to this policy and regulations.

ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO:

1. Be on time for training and all matches. If you are unable to attend training or matches, you **must** inform the team manager or the assistant coach as soon as possible.
2. You **must** respect the coaches and follow any and all instructions given.
3. Respect their team mates and opposition teams and supporters and not engage in any verbal or physical abuse at any time.
4. Be responsible for their own belongings. The Club will not be responsible or held liable for any monetary loss or the loss of any possessions.
5. Address the coach, team manager with any concern or problem. The coach/team manager will take the appropriate action.
6. Report for state team duties if selected.
7. Be properly attired for all official games and functions (i.e. official club tracksuit jacket and playing uniforms).
8. Players are to participate to the best of their ability.
9. Players will be humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
10. Arguing and/or complaining/disputing with referees/officials is unacceptable.
11. Verbal and physical intimidation of opposition team members is unacceptable.
12. Players are to shake hands with their opponents at the conclusion of games.
13. Players will be supportive and encouraging towards team mates at all times. All comments will be positive.
14. All players should attempt to display leadership qualities – you don't have to be the captain to be a leader
15. West Adelaide Soccer Clubs Duty of Care, stems from the FFSA Child Safe Environment Guidelines which is in accordance with the Children's Protection Act 1993, requires parents to be in attendance during the entire training session all season.
16. Be financial to train and play.

PARENT CONDUCT:

1. Parents/guardians of all players are not permitted onto the playing field at any time during training and/or matches.
2. Parents/guardians of all players are ambassadors of the West Adelaide S.C. and as such, are expected to set an example and display a degree of sportsmanship that befits the role. Please refrain from making any verbal comments to the match officials or the players, supporters of the opposing team.
3. Parents/guardians should support, encourage, congratulate and show respect for all in attendance. They **must not** give instructions and/or coach from the side lines. This is the coach's role. The coach is the only person authorised to communicate with the payers.
4. Parents/guardians are encouraged to positively talk to their children after each game, focusing on the areas and opportunities for further growth.
5. Any suggestion or concern is to be submitted to the team manager in the first instance. The team manager will liaise with the coach and will take the appropriate action as required.

REGISTRATION DETAILS:

1. Registration fees cover insurance for injuries incurred in matches, during training and registration with the Football Federation of South Australia.
2. All players must register through MyFootballClub commencement of every new season.
3. Deposits and registration fees are non-refundable.

INJURY DETAILS:

In case of injury the Club uses its discretion to provide medical assistance and is **NOT** liable for any costs incurred. Those providing assistance are indemnified from legal proceedings as an outcome of providing this assistance.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO RECORDING:

During the course of the year, the West Adelaide Soccer Club may take photos/video for promotional purposes. Please notify the Club in writing if you do not wish your child to participate in the above.

Parents/guardians taking photos and/or video of their children must abide by the FFSA Acquiring & Displaying Images of Children guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE: Any breach of the above regulations by parents/guardians, players or officials of the Club will be dealt with by the Club Committee and any penalty imposed will be final.
