

CLUB POLICY AND REGULATIONS 2012

For all players and parents of the WEST ADELAIDE SOCCER CLUB

All players of the West Adelaide S.F.C including U/5's through to U/17's must adhere to this club's policy and regulations.

ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO:

1. Be on time for training and all matches. If you are unable to attend training or matches, you must inform the coach, team manager or the sports director as soon as possible.
 2. You must respect their coaches and follow any and all instructions given.
 3. Respect their team mates and opposition teams and supporters and not engage in any verbal or physical abuse at any time.
 4. Be responsible for their own belongings. The Club will not be responsible or held liable for any monetary loss or the loss of any possessions.
 5. Address the coach, team manager or sports director with any concern or problem.
 6. Report for state team duties if selected.
 7. Be properly attired for all official games and functions (i.e. official club tracksuit jacket and playing uniforms).
 8. Players are to participate to the best of their ability.
 9. Players will be humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
 10. Arguing and/or remonstrating with referees/officials is unacceptable.
 11. Verbal and physical intimidation of opposition team members is unacceptable.
 12. Players are to shake hands with their opponents at the conclusion of games.
 13. Players will be supportive and encouraging towards team mates at all times. All comments will be positive.
 14. All players should attempt to display leadership qualities – you don't have to be the captain to be a leader
 15. West Adelaide Soccer Club encourages parents to be present for all trainings and games. This promotes a positive repour between club / parent / player and also makes things easier for the club / coach to make contact
 16. Be financial to train and play.
1. Parents/guardians of all players are not permitted onto the playing field at any time during training matches.
 2. Parents/guardians of all players are ambassadors of the West Adelaide S.C. and as such, are expected to set an example and display a degree of sportsmanship that befits the role. Please refrain from making any verbal comments to the match officials or the players, supporters of the opposing team.
 3. Any suggestion or concern is to be submitted to the sports director. He will take the appropriate

action to address the suggestion or concern.

1. Registration fees cover insurance for injuries incurred in matches, during training and registration with the Football Federation of South Australia.
2. Players who are registering for the first time, are required to submit a passport sized photo, original birth certificate or passport as proof of identity. Confidentiality is strictly maintained. All original documents will be returned to the owners.

In case of injury the Club uses its discretion to provide medical assistance and is **NOT** liable for any costs incurred. Those providing assistance are indemnified from legal proceedings as an
